COMPANY HISTORY AND PHILOSOPHY

History

DoubleChecked Cybersecurity was founded in 2019 to give small and midsize businesses access to the same level of cybersecurity leadership that large companies rely on. After nearly a decade working in high-pressure IT and cybersecurity roles, I saw firsthand how underserved SMBs were. Most lacked a dedicated security resource, and many struggled to understand what they actually needed.

DoubleChecked began as a hands-on advisory service helping owners make clear, confident decisions about their technology and risk. Over time, the company expanded into a hybrid MSP/MSSP model, offering ongoing protection, Microsoft 365 and Azure security hardening, identity protection, device security, and proactive monitoring.

The company has grown steadily since 2019, serving professional services firms, engineering companies, staffing agencies, retail organizations, and small businesses across the United States. Our focus has always been the same: simplify cybersecurity, make it practical for real businesses, and remove the confusion that often prevents owners from taking action.

Today, DoubleChecked is recognized as a trusted security partner for SMBs that want enterprise-style protection without enterprise-level complexity.
